Pylon Racing

It seems like every time I open an RC magazine now there is either an article on pylon racing or an ad for a foamy pylon airplane. The aircraft that seems to pop-up the most is the HobbyKing EFX Racer. This plug-n-play molded foam racer comes with motor, speed control and servos installed for just \$127.32

The EFX has a 43" wingspan and can fly on both 3S 2200 Lipo or 4S 1800 Lipo. It's available in this red and white version or a yellow and white color scheme. There are numerous carbon reinforcements to make the airframe strong for pylon racing.



Another aircraft I have had my eyes on is the new version Habu 32X, However, this outfit is rather pricy when you see the cost at \$389 and you are just getting started at spending money You still need the fan, motor, speed control, servos , and retracts.



The Habu 32X has a fiberglass fuse and built-up wings, but the steady march of more and more foamy aircraft to the market is unceasing.

Officer Nomination


